1st Hill's Bonnieanne Norman of Tahmor, nice head, eye, good bone, strong body, moved steadily.

Minor Puppy Dog (2, 1a)

1st Whitby's Glengracie Irn Bru at Morivey, good head, eye, ears & expression, strong neck, good bone, moved well. Needs time. Shows promise.

Puppy Dog (0)

Junior Dog (2, 1)

1st Earl's Eskwyre Tom Foolery at Rolanka, well balanced brindle, good head, neck & body with substance, presented in lovely condition. Movement not so pleasing today.

Yearling Dog (2)

1st Bichel-Schmock's Sir Darley's Windsor Wizard, brindle, full of quality, balanced throughout, good head, eye & ears, strong neck & body, low to ground, strong quarters & front end, presented in lovely condition. Moved well. Excellent showman. C.C.
2nd Salmon's Butter Me Scotch Frazer, wheaten, pleasing in head. Could be shorter coupled. Moved steadily & showed well.

Novice Dog (2, 1)

1st Dauncey's Glenmiar Macalstairs, black, well balanced, good head & expression, strong body, good bone. A bit uncertain today. Good coat texture.

Post Grad Dog (5)

1st Meek's Benartybrae Macarene at Benbentham, wheaten, pleasing head, eyes, ears, strong neck, good body & bone, moved well, presented in nice condition, good coat texture.
2nd Peace's Berrybreeze Master Peace, black, pleasing head. A bit upright in shoulder & would like more spring of rib. Well presented & showed well.
3rd Glenmiar Macalstairs.

Limit Dog (5, 3)

1st Beckton's Glengracie Formula One, wheaten, pleasing head, keen expression, good pigment, well coupled, good substance, moved with drive, in lovely condition.
2nd Peace's Berrybreeze Say Cheese, black, head OK, strong body, moved well & presented in nice condition.

Open Dog (6, 1)

1st Rutherford's Carisco Midas Touch, wheaten, well balanced head, good ears, eyes and expression, pigment good, nice neck and layback, well coupled, good bone & in hard condition. Moved with drive, good texture of coat. Pushed hard in the challenge. R.C.C.
2nd Earl's Rolanka Bucks Fizz, balanced head, good eye, ears & expression, well coupled with good depth of body. Lacks angulation. Presented in top condition & showed well.
3rd Miller's Ch Brio Oliver Twist,

Minor Puppy Bitch (2, 1)

1st Becquet & Darby's Kingsview Just One More Bescott, brindle, pleasing head, eye, ears, good neck & body, nice front & strong quarters, good topline showed & moved well, presented in lovely condition. Very promising.

2nd Mill's Blackthorpe Lost In You, nice type, lacks substance. Very outgoing.

Puppy Bitch (3)

1st Boyce's Trakside Fairy Queen, black, very mature bitch, balanced head, good eye, ears, well coupled, good depth of body, moved well & presented in good form.

2nd Cole's Tinka Tykes Golden Girl, wheaten, pleasing head, eye, ears. Could be shorter coupled. Moved steadily, good coat texture.

3rd Botten's Sunshine Daisy, wheaten, very hard to assess, just would not settle. Needs time to settle & to be handled more.

Junior Bitch (5, 2)

1st Kenny & Kirk's Millingford Royal Ermine, black, balanced head, pleasing eye, ears, nice neck, deep body, good bone, moved well. Would like more angulation in rear. Good coat texture & presented well.

2nd Meek's Benartybrae Love in a Mist at Benbetham, brindle, pleasing head. Would like better layback of shoulder. Moved well, presented in nice condition.

3rd Sunshine Daisy

1st Schwarz & Daley's Tredaly Ask Alice, black, balanced head, good body, strong quarters, good bone, harsh coat, showed well.

2nd Mill's Blackthorpe Bianca, neat head. Would like darker eye. Good expression. Would like more substance. Moved well, nice temperament.

Post Grad Bitch (11, 4)

1st Kovaleva's Juscot Royal Tsarina, black, I like this bitch a lot, she has a lovely head, nice eye, good ears & expression, good neck, strong body, well coupled, broad chest. Moved with drive & presented in nice condition. Good ring presence. R.C.C.
